CHORALE : O mighty love
RECIT.: Then the band and the chief captain
AIR : Chains of bondage that I wrought me
RECIT.: And Simon Peter followed Jesus
AIR : I follow in gladness to meet Thee
RECIT.: Now that disciple was known
CHORALE : Ah ! whence this hatred shewn Thee ?
RECIT.: Now Annas had sent Him bound
CHORUS : Art thou not one of His disciples ?
RECIT.: He denied it
AIR : Ah ! my soul, what end awaiteth thee ?
CHORALE : Peter in forgetfulness

CHORALE : He whose life was as the light
RECIT.: Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas
CHORUS : If this man were not a malefactor
RECIT.: Then said Pilate unto them
CHORUS : It is not lawful
RECIT.: That the saying of Jesus
CHORALE : O King of Glory
RECIT.: Pilate therefore said unto Him
CHORUS : Not this man, but Barabbas
RECIT.: Now Barabbas was a robber
ARIOSO : Come, ponder, O my soul
RECIT.: And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns
CHORUS : Hail, Thou King of the Jews

CHORALE : O Christ, Thy fetters mean release
RECIT.: But the Jews cried out
CHORUS : If thou let this man go
RECIT.: When Pilate therefore heard that saying
CHORUS : Away with Him !
RECIT.: Pilate saith unto them
CHORUS : We have no king but Caesar
RECIT.: Then delivered he Him unto them
RECIT.: And there they crucified Him
CHORUS : Write thou not
RECIT.: Pilate answered, What I have written
CHORALE : Thy name is shining on me
RECIT.: The soldiers, therefore, when they had crucified
CHORUS : Let us not divide it
RECIT.: That the scripture might be fulfilled
CHORALE : See Him now the Righteous One
RECIT.: And from that hour
AIR : All is fulfilled
RECIT.: And He bowed His head
AIR (with CHORALE) : My Lord and Saviour

AIR : O heart, melt in weeping
