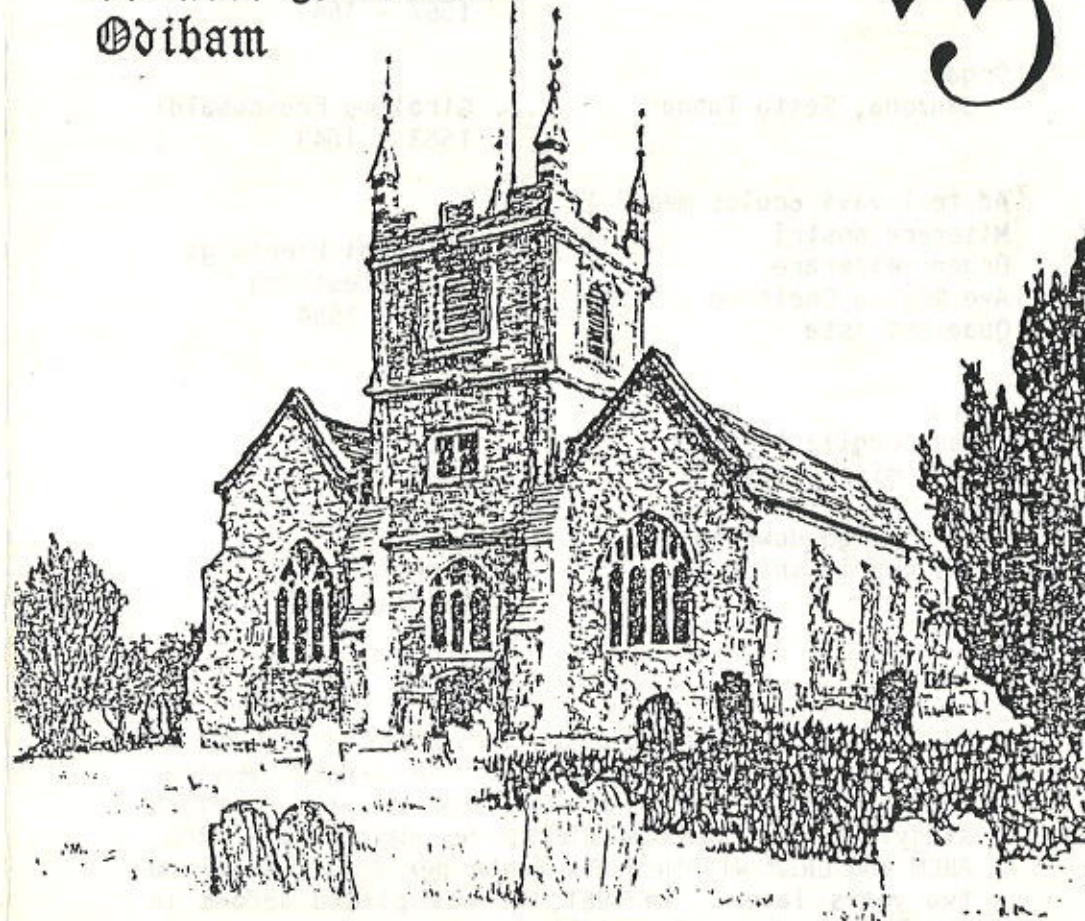

PAUL GRIFFITHS began playing the organ at the age of ten and won first prize in the London Musical Competition Festival at the age of 13. Whilst studying with Malcolm Hicks, he gained the ARCO, ARCM and LRAM within a six-month period and the FRCO two years later. In 1981, he was placed second in the Trianon Organ Competition.

Having been Organist and Choirmaster at St Mary's, Welwyn, from 1980, he moved to Hong Kong in 1986, where he became Assistant Organist at St John's Cathedral and Head of Organ at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. He also featured in broadcasts with the Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra and has given recitals in several countries, including the English Cathedrals of Ely, Peterborough and St Paul's.
