Since its foundation in 1966 by trombonist Leslie Lake, the Locke Brass Consort of London has been active in two spheres. As a quintet it has given many hundreds of educational concerts from Scotland to the Channel Islands and from Wales to Norfolk, and has also given recitals for music clubs throughout the country. In its larger format of a symphonic brass and percussion ensemble it has played a pioneering role in giving performances of larger-scale works, appearing many times at London's South bank and at festivals at home and abroad. In addition to radio broadcasts it has made commercial recordings for labels such as Chandos, CRD, Unicorn, RCA and Koch International, all to great critical acclaim. It has also made appearances on BBC TV's "Songs of Praise".

The Consort has always aimed to promote music of British composers and has commissioned and premiered works by Wilfred Josephs, Daryl Runswick, Gordon Carr, Michael Omer and Gordon Wangford amongst others.

The artists who make up the Locke Brass Consort are either members of London's top symphony and opera orchestras or leading freelance musicians, some being well known as soloists.

Lindsay Bridgwater was educated at Cambridge University where he gained an Honours Degree in Music. He also holds diplomas from Trinity College of Music (LTCL) and the Royal College of Organists (ARCO). His varied career continues to embrace all kinds of music-making. During the eighties he toured, as keyboard player, with Ozzy Osbourne - and he recalled some of these adventures in a recent BBC1 programme "You only live once".

Lindsay is now based in Staines and is well known as an organist and accompanist to various choirs, particularly Ashford Choral Society with whom he has been associated for nearly twenty years.

He has composed and arranged music for the small screen and for radio. He makes frequent appearances with many of the leading orchestras, particularly the Philharmonia, with whom he has completed two extensive tours; - one for the Millennium "Walt Disney's Fantasia" celebrations - which visited the USA and Japan - and another in which he played harpsichord continuo in Haydn's *Creation* in performances across the globe, culminating in a special concert for the Pope's eightieth birthday in the Vatican.

He has a strong connection with Musical Theatre, having acted as Musical Director of *Blood Brothers*, as well as accompanying and coaching for several Musicals for Radio 2 during the nineties. He has worked with Hounslow Musical Theatre where he was MD for *Into the Woods* and for *Sweet Charity* performed recently at the Paul Robeson Theatre.

Malcolm Hicks graduated in Music at the University of Birmingham where he was also Assistant Master of the Music at the Cathedral, and organist and Assistant Conductor with major choirs and orchestras. After further studies in piano, cello, singing and conducting at the Guildhall School of Music, he has since pursued a full-time career as a keyboard player and conductor. He plays with all the major London orchestras in South Bank concerts, Proms, many broadcasts for radio and TV, films, recordings and on tour abroad, many times in Europe, and as far afield as Japan, Korea, North and South America and the former USSR. He was Associate Conductor of the London Philharmonic Choir and Deputy Conductor of the Royal Choral Society for many years, and continues to work regularly with them as choirmaster and with other principal choirs in London, including the London Symphony Chorus, the BBC Symphony Chorus and the BBC Singers amongst others. He was appointed Musical Director of the Waverley Singers in May 1982.
